What is a GED certificate?

- A GED, or General Educational Development, certificate means you have the same skills as someone who has a high school diploma.
- To get a GED certificate, you must pass some tests on subjects like English, science, and math.

Use a GED certificate to

- Get a better job.
- Increase your family's financial security.
- Go to college.

Take the GED tests if you are

- At least 16 years old and do not have a high school diploma.
- Not enrolled in any high school.
- Able to meet your state's requirements for eligibility.

To take the GED tests

- Contact your local adult education program for more information.

Special considerations

You might need a different kind of test setup from other people, like more time to take the test, a Braille version, or being able to use a talking calculator. You can ask for these accommodations when you arrange your test time with the GED testing center.
